Have you ever come to a place in your life that it feels like you've reached the end of the rope? Ever experienced the state of being 'sick and tired of being sick and tired?' Maybe just 'drained!' This was true for a woman in the bible named Hannah who "had no children."(1 Sam. 1:2) She so desperately wanted a child combined with the culture of that day it was almost like a curse to be barren. She had also been provoked by another woman and cried out to the Lord with bitter tears (reaching the end of your rope!)1 Sam. 1:10) What have you so desperately wanted for more days than you can count?
