February can be long and brutal to our psyche. Cold and dampness sets in and can be discouraging. Its like a camping or hiking trip gone bad in the worst of conditions. The stormy, wet conditions can ruin your rest and be tempted to whine and complain. I was never much of the camper type. Sorry all you wilderness outdoorsy people. Which brings me to a time in history where a chosen group of people set out for a little camping exploration. They were promised something far better than a pot of gold at the end of the rainbow! Twelve explorers or spies were sent out to check out this amazing land of Canaan. But instead of trusting God that all would be well no matter what “giants” and trials they faced God would “certainly allow them to go up and take possession of the land.”(num.13:30) Overcome and paralyzed by fear they grieved the heart of God.
