Encouragement from Pastor Kirk

March madness is a glorious time for basketball lovers. I used to be one but no more dunkin for me except dunkin donuts! March madness is that time of annual NCAA college basketball tournaments played throughout March. Most of this probably doesn't matter to many of you. Our minds are on more pressing issues. One pressing issue I would like to share with you is about two completely different people with different mindsets and mission. There are many insights for us in the story. One "lost their mind" (talk about march madness!) and the other maintained a spiritual mindset filled with peace. It's the familiar story in 1 Sam. 15 and 16 of David who was chosen by God and obedient to His will and Saul who started off anointed by God but ended up repeatedly disobeying. If not careful we can "lose our minds" too. We can get mad at the weather, winter and wisecracks for driving us crazy but those are not the root cause. The bible states that Saul was terrorized or troubled in his mind. His disobedience led to some judgment from God which was a "mental disturbance bordering on madness" according to theologian Charles Ryrie. We may not experience this trouble in the same fashion but I have experienced some "madness" in the sense of lacking peace or joy because I grieved the Spirit. That would be our NT equivalent to what happened to Saul. "The Spirit of the LORD departed from him." It creates havoc in our hearts and lives. I want to be like David-"the LORD is with him." Because in part he was obedient to the Lord he found favor with God. As followers of Christ he will "never leave you or forsake you" but we can miss what he wants us to experience with Him. I want to more fully embrace his love for me. To receive it will lead to sharing it. And thank you all for sharing the love of God with our dear residents! Continue to embrace Him and his word in obedience and experience his love in fresh ways(Jn. 14:21). This will keep you fresh even in the madness of march weather or whatever giants you face.
